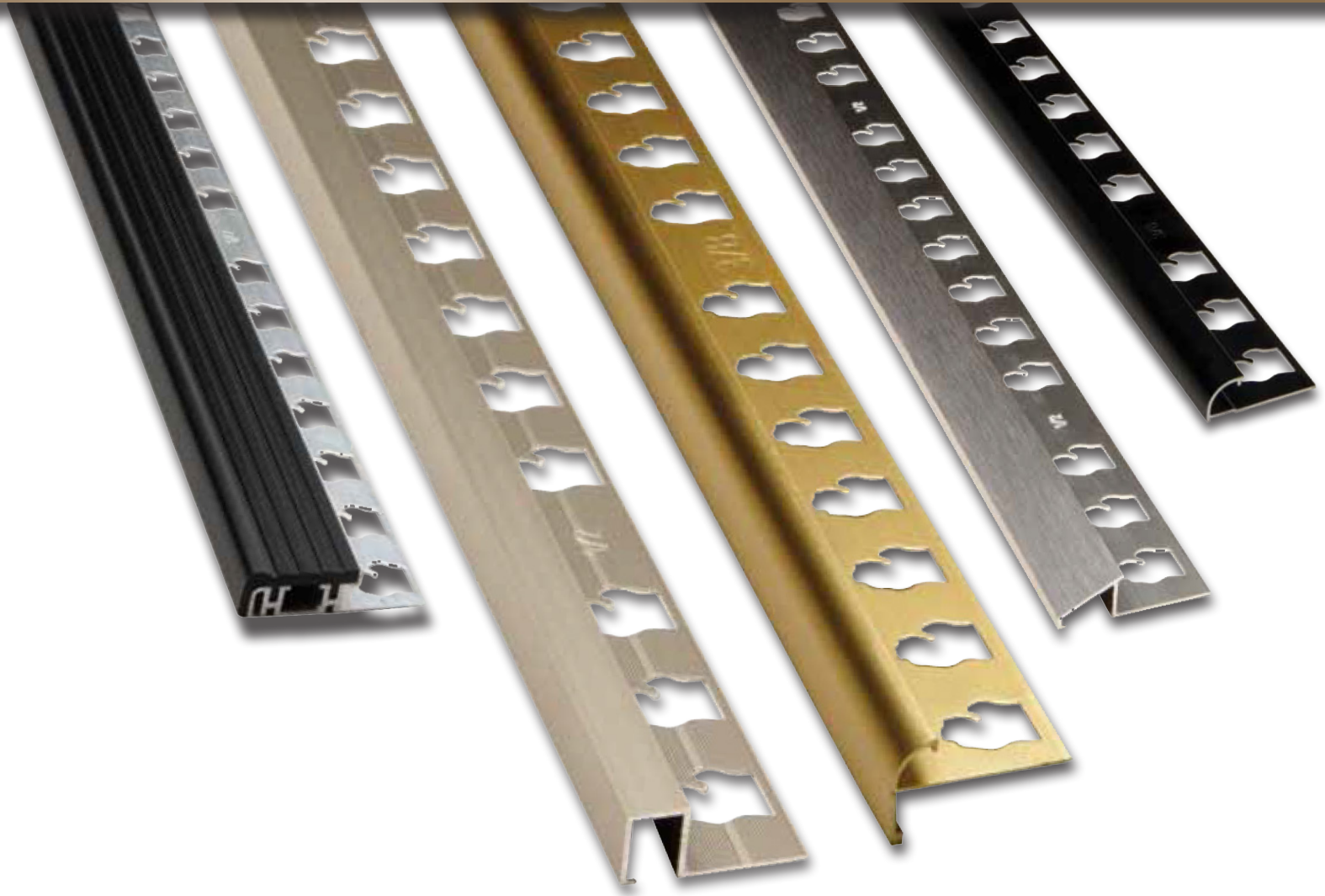

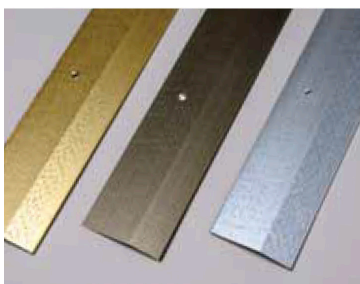

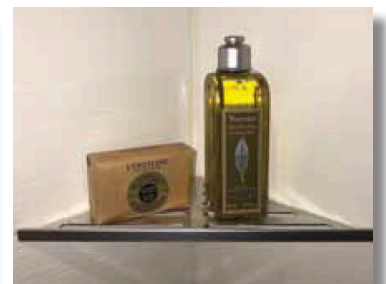

What is the difference between a Mill and Anodized Finish?

Anodizing is an electro-chemical process used to promote the growth of aluminum oxide which is then color dyed and sealed. This process gives the aluminum a decorative, appealing finish which also significantly reduces the corrosion of aluminum alloy. Non-anodized aluminum, also known as "Mill" finish, when exposed to room temperature (oxygen) will begin the natural corrosion process, which produces an aluminum oxide on the surface. Mill finish is more susceptible to scratches.

L Channel

This universal trim can be used in a variety of applications including, but not limited to, a corner guard on vertical wall applications. Available in numerous finishes to coordinate with any tile or stone selection.

Round Edge

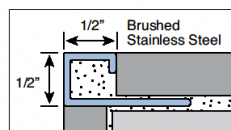
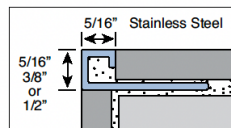
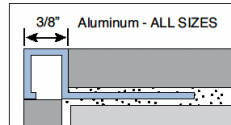


A unique and cost effective alternative to expensive bull nose and/or tile trim pieces. A great way to finish and soften tile edges on wall applications.

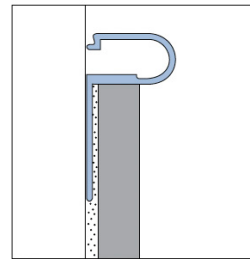
Square Edge



An accent trim which can be used to trim a corner edge or used between tiles in a wall application. Corners are also available.

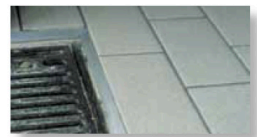
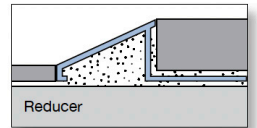


Round Edge Top Cap

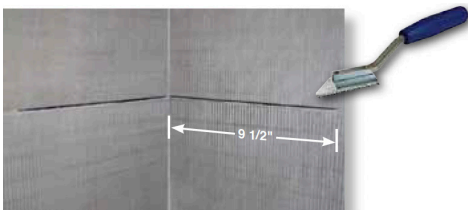
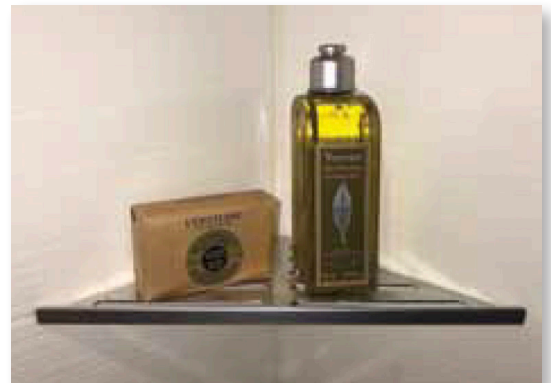

Reducer



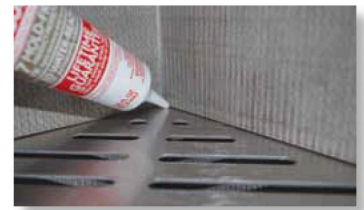
Clever Corner - Shower Corner Shelf NEW!



- Remove grout approximately 9 1/2" from inner corner on each wall using a grout saw or rotary tool.



- Apply silicone in the grout cavity and/or on the edge of the shelf.
- Insert the Clever Corner Shower Shelf into the grout joint and allow the silicone to cure.



- Finish installation with additional silicone or color matching grout caulk to form a water-tight seal.
